- **F. No. HQ-PPI01/8/2022-PP_1:** Staff Selection Commission (SSC) will conduct an open competitive examination for recruitment to the post of Scientific Assistant in India Meteorological Department (IMD), Group 'B' Non-Gazetted, Non-Ministerial post, in the Level 6 of the Pay Matrix as per the Recruitment Scheme formulated by the IMD and as per the Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) signed between IMD and SSC. The salient features of the recruitment areas under:
 - 1.1. The Examination will be advertised by SSC based on vacancies intimated by IMD.
 - 1.2. Applications from the candidates for the examination will be accepted through online mode only.
 - 1.3. The Staff Selection Commission will conduct the examination in "Computer Based Examination" (CBE) Mode in Hindi and English, on Pan India basis depending on

the number of applicants from different States and UTs. Call letters for the Computer Based Examination will be uploaded on the websites of the Regional Offices concerned of the Staff Selection Commission and a "Notice" about information regarding Admit Card/ Admission Certificate will be provided on the website of IMD.

- 1.4. The Document Verification will be conducted by the IMD. IMD will issue the Admission Certificates for DV to candidates through its website. A notice regarding the DV will also be uploaded on the website of the Commission.
- 1.5. The final result will be processed and declared by the Commission on its website. A 'reserve panel/additional list' of 50% candidates (category-wise) will also be prepared by the Staff Selection Commission in addition to the number of candidates selected as per the notified vacancies and the same will be provided to IMD in a sealed cover, not to be uploaded. The "Reserve Panel" will be valid for a period of one and half years from the date of declaration of result.
- 1.6. Court Cases/ RTI/ Public Grievances relating to Notice of Examination excluding issues related to IMD, on-line application, conduct of Computer Based Examination and preparation of Merit List would be handled by the Staff Selection Commission. The remaining court cases/ RTI/ Public grievances etc. will be handled by the IMD.
- 1.7. The process of cancellation of candidature of candidates found indulging in any malpractice or impersonation etc. during the conduct of Computer Based Examination will be handled by the SSC.
- 1.8. The cases of candidates found indulging in any malpractice or impersonation etc. during the conduct of the DV will be handled by the IMD.
- 1.9. Any representation regarding change (inclusion/exclusion) in the Merit List/ Reserve List due to wrong/incorrect DV data will be handled by the IMD.

2. TENTATIVE VACANCIES / RESERVATION:

- 2.1. Total Vacancies: About 990.
- 2.2. The number of vacancies is tentative and subject to variation.
- 2.3. Reservation for Scheduled Castes (SC), Scheduled Tribes (ST), Other Backward Classes (OBC), Economically Weaker Sections (EWS) and Persons with Benchmark Disabilities (PwBD) candidates is available as per extant Government Orders.
- 2.4. The posts have been identified suitable for the persons suffering from disabilities of One Arm affected (OA) or One Leg affected (OL) and Dwarfism (Dw) or Acid Attack Victims (AAV).
- 2.5. The posts carry All India Service Liability (AISL) i.e. the candidate, on selection, may be asked to serve anywhere in the country.

3. NATIONALITY / CITIZENSHIP:

- 3.1. A candidate must be either:
 - 3.1.1. a citizen of India, or
 - 3.1.2. a subject of Nepal, or
 - 3.1.3. a subject of Bhutan, or

- 3.1.4. a Tibetan refugee who came over to India, before the 1st January, 1962 with the intention of permanently settling in India, or
- 3.1.5. a person of Indian origin who has migrated from Pakistan, Burma, Sri Lanka, East African Countries of Kenya, Uganda, the United Republic of Tanzania (Formerly Tanganyika and Zanzibar), Zambia, Malawi, Zaire, Ethiopia and Vietnam with the intention of permanently settling in India.
- 3.2. Provided that a candidate belonging to categories (3.1.2), (3.1.3), (3.1.4) and (3.1.5) above shall be a person in whose favour a certificate of eligibility has been issued by the Government of India.
- 3.3. A candidate in whose case a certificate of eligibility is necessary may be admitted to the Examination but the offer of appointment will be given only after the necessary eligibility certificate has been issued to him by the Government of India.

4. Age limit (As on closing date 18-10-2022):

- 4.1. Age limit: Not exceeding 30 years as on 18-10-2022. Candidate must have been born not earlier than 19-10-1992 and not later than 17-10-2004.
- 4.2. Permissible relaxation in upper age limit and category-codes for claiming age relaxation are as follows:

4.3. Date of Birth filled by the candidate in the online application form and the same recorded in the Matriculation/ Secondary Examination Certificate will be accepted by the Commission for determining the age and no subsequent request for change will be considered or granted.

- 4.4. The post of Scientific Assistant being a Group 'B' post, there is no reservation for Ex-Servicemen category. However, benefit of age-relaxation will be admissible to Ex-Serviceman candidates, as per extant Govt. Orders.
- 4.5. The period of "Call up Service" of an Ex-Serviceman in the Armed Forces shall also be treated as service rendered in the Armed Forces for purpose of age relaxation, as per rules.
- 4.6. For any serviceman of the three Armed Forces of the Union to be treated as Ex-Serviceman for the purpose of securing the benefits of age-relaxation, he must have already acquired, at the relevant time of submitting his application for the Post/Service, the status of ex-serviceman or is in a position to establish his acquired entitlement by documentary evidence from the competent authority that he would complete specified term of engagement from the Armed Forces within the stipulated period of one year from the closing date for receipt of application i.e. 18-10-2023. Such candidates must also acquire the status of an ex-serviceman within the stipulated period of one year from the closing date of receipt of applications.
- 4.7. Explanation: An 'ex-serviceman' means a person:
 - 4.7.1. who has served in any rank whether as a combatant or non-combatant in the regular Army, Navy and Air Force of the Indian Union, and
 - 4.7.1.1. Who either has been retired or relieved or discharged from such service whether at his own request or being relieved by the employer after earning his pension; or
 - 4.7.1.2. Who has been relieved from such service on medical grounds attributable to military service or circumstances beyond his control and awarded medical or other disability pension; or
 - 4.7.1.3. Who has been released from such service as a result of reduction in establishment;

or

4.7.2. Who has been released from such service after completing the specific period of engagement, otherwise than at his own request, or by way of dismissal, or discharge on account of misconduct or inefficiency and has been given a gratuity; and includes personnel of the Territorial Army, namely, pension holders for continuous embodied service or broken spells of qualifying service;

or

4.7.3. Personnel of the Army Postal Service who are part of Regular Army and retired from the Army Postal Service without reversion to their parent service with pension, or are released from the Army Postal service on medical grounds attributable to or aggravated by military service or circumstance beyond their control and awarded medical or other disability pension;

or

4.7.4. Personnel, who were on deputation in Army Postal Service for more than six months prior to the 14th April, 1987;

or

4.7.5. Gallantry award winners of the Armed forces including personnel of Territorial Army;

- 4.7.6. Ex-recruits boarded out or relieved on medical ground and granted medical disability pension.
- 4.8. Age relaxation/ ESM reservation is not admissible to sons, daughters and dependents of Ex-Servicemen. Therefore, such candidates should not indicate their category as ex-servicemen.

5. Process of Certification and Format of Certificates:

- 5.1. Candidates who wish to be considered against reserved vacancies or seek agerelaxation must submit requisite certificate from the competent authority, in the prescribed format when such certificates are sought by IMD at the time of document verification. Otherwise, their claim for SC/ST/OBC/EWS/PwBD/ESM category will not be entertained and their candidature/ application will be considered under Unreserved (UR)/ relevant category. The formats of the certificates are annexed with the Notice of this Examination. The certificate of disability issued under the Persons with Disabilities (Equal Opportunities, Protection of Rights and Full Participation) Act, 1995 (1 of 1996) will also be valid. Certificates in any other format are liable to be rejected.
- 5.2. Crucial date for claim of SC/ ST/ OBC/ EWS/ PwBD status or any other benefit viz. fee concession, reservation, age-relaxation, etc., where not specified otherwise, will be the closing date for receipt of online applications i.e.18-10-2022.
- 5.3. A person seeking appointment on the basis of reservation to OBCs must ensure that he possesses the caste/ community certificate and does not fall in creamy layer on the crucial date.
- 5.4. Candidates may also note that in respect of the above, their candidature will remain provisional till the veracity of the concerned document is verified by the Appointing Authority. Candidates are cautioned that they will be debarred from the examination conducted by the Commission in case they fraudulently claim SC/ ST/ OBC/ EWS/ PwBD/ ESM status or avail any other benefit.

6. Provision of Compensatory Time and assistance of scribe:

- 6.1. In case of persons with benchmark disabilities in the following categories i.e. One-Arm affected (OA), One-Leg Affected (OL), Dwarfism (Dw) and Acid Attack Victim (AAV) the facility of scribe is provided, if desired by the candidate on production of a certificate at the time of examination to the effect that the person concerned has physical limitation to write, and scribe is essential to write examination on his behalf, from the Chief Medical Officer/ Civil Surgeon/ Medical Superintendent of a Government health care institution as per proforma at Annexure-I.
- 6.2. The facility of scribes/ passage reader will be provided to the PwBD candidates only if he/she has opted for the same in the online application form.
- 6.3. The candidate will have the discretion of opting for his/her own scribe or to avail the facility of scribe provided by the Commission. Appropriate choice in this regard will have to be given by the candidate in the online application form.
- 6.4. In case the candidate opts for his own scribe, the qualification of the scribe should be one step below the qualification of the candidate taking the examination. The

candidates with benchmark disabilities opting for own scribe shall be required to submit details of the own scribe at the time of examination as per proforma at Annexure-II. In addition, the scribe has to produce a valid ID proof (as per list given at para-13.7) in original at the time of examination. A photocopy of the ID proof of the scribe signed by the candidate as well as the scribe will be submitted along with proforma at Annexure-II. If subsequently it is found that the qualification of the scribe is not as declared by the candidate, then the candidate shall forfeit his right to the post and claims relating thereto.

- 6.5. If a candidate opts for his/her own scribe, in that case, that scribe should not be a candidate of this examination. If a candidate is detected as assisting another PwBD candidate as scribe in this examination, then the candidatures of both the candidates will be cancelled.
- 6.6. A compensatory time of 20 minutes per hour of examination will be provided to the persons who are allowed use of scribe as described at Para 6.1 above.
- 6.7. The candidates referred at Para 6.1 who are eligible for use of scribe but not availing the facility of scribe will also be given compensatory time of 20 minutes per hour of examination.
- 6.8. No attendant other than the scribe for eligible candidates will be allowed inside the Examination Hall.
- 6.9. The PwBD candidates who have availed the facility of scribes/ passage reader and/ or compensatory time must produce relevant documents for the eligibility of scribe/ compensatory time at the time of Document Verification. Failure to produce such supporting documents will lead to cancellation of their candidature for the examination.

7. Essential Educational Qualifications (As on 18-10-2022):

7.1. Bachelor's Degree in Science (with Physics as one of the subject)/Computer Science/Information Technology/Computer Applications

OR

Diploma in Electronics and Telecommunication Engineering from a recognized Institution/University or equivalent.

- NOTE-I: The qualifying Degree or Diploma referred above should be in First Class (60% marks) or 6.75 CGPA on a 10 point scale.
- NOTE-II: The qualifying Degree or Diploma referred above must be of three (3) years duration after (10+2) examination.
- NOTE-III: The applicant must have passed 10+2 Examination from a Recognized Board or equivalent in Science with Physics and Mathematics as core subjects.
- 7.2. The candidates who have appeared in their final year of their graduation can also apply, however they must possess Essential qualification on or before the cut-off date i.e.18-10-2022.
- 7.3. As per Ministry of Human Resource Development Notification dated 10-06-2015 published in the Gazette of India all the degrees/ diplomas/ certificates awarded through Open and Distance Learning mode of education by the Universities established by an Act of Parliament or State Legislature, Institutions Deemed to be

Universities under Section 3 of the University Grants Commission Act, 1956 and Institutions of National Importance declared under an Act of Parliament stand automatically recognized for the purpose of employment to posts and services under the Central Government provided they have been approved by the Distance Education Bureau, University Grants Commission. Accordingly, unless such degrees are recognized for the relevant period when the candidates acquired the qualification, they will not be accepted for the purpose of Educational Qualification. In case of the candidates possessing such degrees/diplomas/ certificates awarded through Open and Distance Learning mode of education, such candidates shall also produce approval given to the University by the Distance Education Bureau, University Grants Commission for the relevant period at the time of Document Verification.

- 7.4. As per UGC (Open and Distance Learning) Regulations, 2017 published in official Gazette on 23-06-2017, under Part-III (8) (v), the programmes in engineering, medicine, dental, nursing, pharmacy, architecture and physiotherapy etc. are not permitted to be offered under Open and Distance Learning mode. However, pursuant to the Hon'ble Supreme Court Order dated 11-03-2019 in MA No. 3092/2018 in W.P. (C) No. 382/2018 titled Mukul Kumar Sharma & others Vs AICTE and others, B. Tech. degree/ diploma in Engineering awarded by IGNOU to the students who were enrolled up to academic year 2009-10 shall be treated as valid, wherever applicable.
- 7.5. All the candidates who are called for documents verification will be required to produce the relevant Certificates such as Mark sheets for all years/semesters of Graduation/ Provisional Certificate/ Degree of Graduation in original as proof of having acquired the minimum educational qualification on or before the cut-off date, failing which the candidature of such candidates will be cancelled by the Commission. The candidates who are able to prove, by documentary evidence, that the result of the qualifying examination was declared on or before the cut-off date and he has been declared passed, will also be considered to meet the educational qualification. It is reiterated that the result of requisite educational qualification must have been declared by the Institute/ University by the specified date. Mere processing of the result by the University/ Institute by the cut-off date does not fulfill the EQ requirement.
- 7.6. In case of the candidates possessing equivalent educational qualification, such candidates shall also produce relevant Equivalence Certificate from the authorities concerned at the time of Document Verification. However, final decision regarding selection of such candidates will be taken by the India Meteorological Department (IMD).

8. How to apply:

- 8.1. Applications must be submitted only in online mode at the website of SSC Headquarter i.e. https://ssc.nic.in. For detailed instructions, please refer to <u>Annexure-III and Annexure-IV. Sample proforms of One-time Registration and online Application Form are attached as <u>Annexure-IIIA and <u>Annexure-IVA</u> respectively.</u></u>
- 8.2. In the online Application Form, candidates are required to upload the scanned colour passport size photograph in JPEG format (20 KB to 50 KB). The photograph should not be more than three months old from the date of publication of the Notice of Examination. Image dimension of the photograph

- should be about 3.5 cm (width) x 4.5 cm (height). The photograph should be without cap, spectacles and the frontal view of the face should be clearly visible.
- 8.3. If the proper photograph is not uploaded by a candidate, his candidature will be cancelled. Specimen of photographs which are acceptable/ not acceptable is given at Annexure-V.
- 8.4. Last date and time for submission of online applications is 18-10-2022 (23:00).
- 8.5. Candidates are advised in their own interest to submit the online application much before the closing date and not to wait till the last date to avoid the possibility of disconnection/ inability or failure to login to the SSC website on account of heavy load on the website during the closing days.
- 8.6. The Commission will not be responsible for the candidates not being able to submit their applications within the last date on account of the aforesaid reasons or for any other reason beyond the control of the Commission.
- 8.7. Before submission of the online application, candidates must check through Preview/ Print option that they have filled correct details in each field of the form.

9. Application Fee:

- 9.1. Fee payable: ₹100/- (Rupee One Hundred Only).
- 9.2. Women candidates and candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes (SC), Scheduled Tribes (ST), Persons with Benchmark Disabilities (PwBD)and Ex-servicemen (ESM) are exempted from payment of fee.
- 9.3. Fee can be paid online through BHIM UPI, Net Banking or by using Visa, Mastercard, Maestro, RuPay Credit or Debit cards or in cash at SBI Branches by generating SBI Challan.
- 9.4. Online fee can be paid by candidates up to 20-10-2022 (23:00 hours) and candidates who wish to make cash payment through the challan of SBI, may make payment in cash at the Branches of SBI within the working hours of bank up to 20-10-2022 provided the challan has been generated by them before 19-10-2022 (23:00 hours).
- 9.5. Candidates who are not exempted from fee payment must ensure that their fee has been deposited with SSC. If the fee is not received by SSC, status of the Application Form is shown as 'Incomplete' and this information is printed on the top of the printout of online Application Form. Further, status of fee payment can be verified at the 'Payment Status' link provided in the candidate's login screen. Such applications which remain incomplete due to non-receipt of fee will be SUMMARILY REJECTED and no request for consideration of such applications and fee payment after the period specified in the Notice of Examination shall be entertained.
- 9.6. Fee once paid shall not be refunded under any circumstances nor will it be adjusted against any other examination or selection.

10. Window for Application Form Correction [25-10-2022 (upto 23:00 hrs)]:

10.1. After the closing date for receipt of online applications, the Commission will provide a period of one (1) day to enable candidates to correct/ modify online application parameters, wherein candidates will be allowed to re-submit

- applications after making requisite corrections/ changes in the one-time registration/ online application data as per their requirement.
- 10.2. A candidate will be allowed to correct and re-submit his modified/ corrected application two times during the 'Window for Application Form Correction' i.e. if he has made mistake in his updated application also, he will be allowed to re-submit one more modified/ corrected application after making requisite corrections/ modifications. No more corrections in the application form will be allowed under any circumstances.
- 10.3. Only those candidates will be allowed to make corrections in the application form, whose completed online applications along-with payment of requisite fee, have been received by the Commission within the specified period.
- 10.4. The Commission will levy a uniform correction charges of ₹200/- for making correction(s) and re-submitting modified/ corrected application for the first time and ₹500/- for making correction(s) and re-submitting modified/ corrected application for the second time. The correction charges will be applicable to all candidates irrespective of their gender/ category.
- 10.5. The correction charges can be paid only by online mode through BHIM UPI, Net Banking or by using Visa, Mastercard, Maestro, RuPay Credit or Debit cards.
- 10.6. The correction charges once paid shall not be refunded under any circumstances nor will it be adjusted against any other examination or selection.
- 10.7. Subject to the receipt of applicable correction charges, the latest modified/corrected application will be treated as the valid one and the previous application(s) submitted by such candidates will be cancelled.
- 10.8. If the applicable correction charges are not received by the SSC, status of Application Form is shown as '**Incomplete**' and this information is printed on the top of the Application Form printout. Such application shall not be accepted and the previously submitted application will remain valid.
- 10.9. Before submission of the corrected application, candidates must check that they have filled correct details in each field of the form. After expiry of 'Window for Application Form Correction', no change/ correction/ modification will be allowed under any circumstances. Requests received in this regard in any form like Post, Fax, Email, by hand, etc. shall not be entertained by the Commission and will be summarily rejected.

11. Centres of Examination:

11.1. A candidate must indicate the Centre(s) in the online Application Form in which he/she desires to take the examination. Details about the Examination Centres and Regional Offices under whose jurisdiction these Examination Centres are located are as follows:

- 11.2. A candidate has to give option for three centres, in the order of priority, within the same Region. No request for change of centre at any stage of the examination will be considered later under any circumstances. Hence, the candidates should select the centres, carefully and indicate the same correctly in their applications.
- 11.3. The Commission will endeavour to accommodate the candidates in centres opted by them. However, the Commission reserves the right to cancel any Centre and ask the candidates of that centre to appear from another centre. Commission also reserves the right to divert candidates of any centre to some other Centre to take the examination.

12. Scheme of the Examination:

- 12.1. The Commission will conduct a Computer Based Examination comprising 200 questions carrying 200 marks for two hours duration.
- 12.2. The question paper would have two parts, Part-I and Part-II as detailed below:

- 12.3. The candidates will be required to attempt both Part-I and Part-II of the examination. Part-II of examination will be on the basis of subject opted in the online application form. In other words, the candidates opting for Physics will be required to attempt Physics paper, the candidates opting for Computer Science & IT will be required to attempt Computer Science & IT paper and the candidates opting for Electronics & Telecommunication Engineering will be required to attempt Electronics & Telecommunication Engineering paper in Part-II, failing which their candidature will be rejected.
- 12.4. The examination will consist of Objective Type, Multiple choice questions only. The questions will be set both in English & Hindi except for questions of English Language & Comprehensions.
- 12.5. There will be negative marking of 0.25 marks for each wrong answer in the examination. Candidates are, therefore, advised to keep this in mind while answering the questions.
- 12.6. The Commission may conduct the examination in multiple shifts. Marks scored by candidates in Computer Based Examinations, if conducted in multiple shifts, will be normalized by using the formula published by the Commission vide Notice No: 1-1/2018-P&P-I dated 07-02-2019 and such normalized scores will be used to determine final merit and cut-off marks.
- 12.7. Tentative Answer Keys of the Computer Based Examinations will be placed on the website of the Commission after the Examination. Candidates may go through the Answer Keys and submit online representations, if any, within the stipulated time limit on payment of ₹100/- per question, which is non-refundable. Representations received through any other mode e.g. letter, application, email, etc. will not be entertained. Representation regarding the Answer Keys will be scrutinized before finalizing the Answer Keys and the decision of the Commission in this regard will be final.
- 12.8. The schedule of examinations indicated in the Notice is tentative. Any change in the schedule of examinations will be informed to candidates only through the website of the Commission.
- 12.9. In the question papers, wherever necessary, the Metric systems of weights and measures will be used.
- 12.10. There shall be no provision for re-evaluation/re-checking of the scores of any stage of the examination. No correspondence in this regard shall be entertained.

- Quantitative Aptitude: The questions will be designed to test the ability of 12.11.3 appropriate use of numbers and number sense of the candidate. The scope of the test will be computation of whole numbers, decimals, fractions and relationships between numbers, Percentage, Ratio & Proportion, Square roots, Averages, interest, Profit and Loss, Discount, Partnership Business, Mixture and Alligation, Time and Distance, Time & Work, Basic algebraic identities of School Algebra & Elementary Surds, Graphs of Linear Equations, Triangle and its various kinds of center, Congruence and similarity of triangles, Circle and its chords, tangents, angles subtended by chords of a circle, common tangents to two or more circles, Triangle, Quadrilaterals, Regular Polygons, Circle, Right Prism, Right Circular Cone, Right Circular Cylinder, Sphere, Hemispheres, Rectangular Parallelepiped, Regular Right Pyramid with triangular or square base, Trigonometric ratio, Degree and Radian Measures, Standard Identities, Complementary angle, Heights and Distances, Histogram, Frequency polygon, Bar diagram & Pie chart.
- 12.11.4 **English Language and Comprehension** English grammar, Vocabulary, Spellings, Synonyms and Antonyms, Comprehension, Correct and incorrect usages, etc.

- 13.2. The Commission will not undertake detailed scrutiny of applications for the eligibility and other aspects at the time of written examination and, therefore, candidature will be accepted only provisionally. Candidates must go through the requirements of educational qualification, experience, age, physical and medical standards etc. and satisfy themselves that they are eligible for the post. The certificates/documents in support of their Educational Qualifications and Caste/Category, etc. shall be sought at the time of Document Verification by the IMD. Physical and medical standards will be ascertained by the IMD after the declaration of result. Candidates may also note that they would be required to submit their certificates or documents of EQs/ caste/ category, etc. as and when sought by the IMD. 15. Mode of Selection:

- 15.1 The result of the Computer Based Examination will be declared by the Staff Selection Commission. For the categories having up to 10 vacancies, the candidates who come within the range of merit of Computer Based Examination equal to 5 times the number of vacancies in each category General (UR)/SC/ST/OBC/EWS/PwBD and Ex-servicemen (category-wise) will be shortlisted for appearing in the document verification. For the categories having more than 10 vacancies, candidates in the ratio of 3 times the number of vacancies, subject to minimum 50 candidates, will be shortlisted for appearing in the DV.
- 15.2 On receipt of DV data from IMD, final result will be processed and declared by the Commission on its website. A reserve panel/ additional list of 50% candidates (category wise) will be prepared by the Commission in addition to the number of candidates selected as per notified vacancies. The list of reserve panel will be provided to IMD in a sealed cover and will not be uploaded on the website. The reserve panel will be valid for a period of one and half years from the date of declaration of result.
- 15.3 SC, ST, OBC and PH candidates, who are selected on their own merit without relaxed standards, along with candidates belonging to other communities, will not be adjusted against the reserved share of vacancies. Such SC, ST, OBC and PH candidates will be accommodated against the general/unreserved vacancies in the post as per their position in the overall Merit List or vacancies earmarked for their category, whichever is advantageous to them. The reserved vacancies will be filled up separately from amongst the eligible SCs, STs, OBCs and PH candidates.
- 15.4 A suitable person with benchmark disability (PwBD) who qualifies this examination under UR standards can be appointed against an unreserved vacancy.
- 15.5 Reserved category candidate who qualifies on the basis of relaxed standards viz. age limit, experience or qualifications, permitted number of chances in written examination, extended zone of consideration, etc. will be counted against reserved vacancies and not against UR vacancies subject to fitness of such candidate for selection. Such candidates may also be recommended at the relaxed standards to fill

- up the number of vacancies reserved for them, irrespective of their rank in the order of merit. In so far as cases of Ex-Serviceman are concerned, deduction from the age of Ex-Servicemen is permissible and such exemption will not be termed as relaxed standards in regard to age.
- 15.6 Success in the examination confers no right of appointment unless Government is satisfied after such enquiry as may be considered necessary that the candidate is suitable in all respects for appointment to the service/post.
- 15.7 Candidates applying for the examination should ensure that they fulfill all the eligibility conditions for admission to the examination. Their admission at all stages of the examination will be purely provisional, subject to their satisfying the prescribed eligibility conditions. If, on verification, at any time before or after the written examination, it is found that they do not fulfill any of the eligibility conditions, their candidature for the examination will be cancelled by the Commission.

16. Action against candidates found guilty of misconduct:

16.1 If candidates are found to indulge at any stage in any of the malpractices listed below, their candidature for this examination will be cancelled and they will be debarred from the examinations of the Commission for the period mentioned below:

- 16.2 The Commission may also report the matter to Police/ Investigating Agencies, as deemed fit. Commission may also take appropriate action to get the matter examined by the authorities/ forensic experts concerned.
- 16.3 Court Cases/ RTI/ Public Grievances relating to Notice of Examination excluding issues related to IMD, on-line application, conduct of Computer Based Examination and preparation of Merit List would be handled by the Staff Selection Commission. The remaining court cases/ RTI/ Public grievances etc. will be handled by the IMD.
- 16.4 The process of cancellation of candidature of candidates found indulging in any malpractice or impersonation etc. during the conduct of Computer Based Examination will be handled by the SSC.
- 16.5 The cases of candidates found indulging in any malpractice or impersonation etc. during the conduct of the DV will be handled by the IMD.
- 16.6 Any representation regarding change (inclusion/exclusion) in the Merit List/ Reserve List due to wrong/incorrect DV data will be handled by the IMD

- 17. **Commission's decision final:** The decision of the Commission in all matters relating to eligibility, acceptance or rejection of the applications, penalty for false information, mode of selection, conduct of examination(s), allotment of examination centres, selection and allotment of posts/organizations to selected candidates will be final and binding on the candidates and no enquiry/correspondence will be entertained in this regard.
- 18. **Courts' Jurisdiction:** Any dispute with regard to this recruitment will be subject to courts/ tribunals having jurisdiction over the place of Regional Office concerned of SSC where the candidate has appeared in the examination(s).
- 19. **Disqualifications:** No person, (a) who has entered into, or contracted a marriage with a person having a **spouse** living, or (b) who, having a spouse living has entered into, or contracted a marriage with any person shall be eligible for appointment to the service provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

20. Important Instructions to Candidates:

(Procedure for filling online Application)
